

Is there a wooden palette blocking the sidewalk? Is there a light out on the street where you live? Is there a problem with overgrowth of a tree or bush on city property? Don't know who to report it to?

There is an answer. It's called SeeClickFix and it is designed report and track issues that are brought up in the neighborhood directly to officials in Pinellas County and St Petersburg. This app works with your smartphone or can also be used from a computer.

The smartphone app is can be found wherever you go to download your apps. Be sure to look for the St Pete icon to get the app specific to St. Petersburg. Create an account and you can report an issue by taking a picture of the issue and submitting it city officials. You can also track your issue online if you would like. The PC app is located at <a href="http://seeclickfix.com/">http://seeclickfix.com/</a> There is a box at the top of the screen where you enter your city – St Petersburg FL. The next screen will show the complaints and the status of the complaint in Pinellas County. You can register to report an issue there, follow the page, ask a question or see maps of the area. Hopefully, we can all participate in the larger community and keep St Petersburg beautiful.

#### Treasurer's Report

Cash and Certificates of Deposit as of October 31 total \$40,045. Revenues year-to-date through October 31, 2014 of \$17,036 compared to \$13,143 for the same period last year. The increase is primarily due to a donation to BCA by Rick Janka and an increase in advertising receipts. 2014 year-to date expenses of \$11,832 compared to \$9,038 for the same period last year. The 2014 year-to-date expenditures include \$500 for a donation to Skyway Marina District, Inc. and \$1,439 for street sign repairs.

# Real Estate Report

#### **INSURANCE**

It's a good idea to get additional quotes on your insurance when you get an insurance renewal notice. In several cases when we have listed a Broadwater property for sale, we have asked for insurance quotes for a new buyer and found insurance is available at a significantly lower premium.

Also, if you get a letter from Citizens that they are assigning you to a different company - you do have the right to decline. If you want to stay with Citizens, you will need to sign a form within the deadline - you should be able to get the form from your insurance agent.

#### KTTCHEN APPEAL

According to the PulteGroup Home Index Survey, nearly 30% of Americans say that the kitchen is the most important area when choosing a new home, followed by the Master Bedroom at 22%. Interestingly, it's not the size of the home that counts, it's how efficiently the space is used. We're seeing that here in the neighborhood - buyers are opting to pay more for movein ready homes, rather than less expensive homes that need remodeling.

#### **PROPERTY TAXES**

It's that time of year and 2014 tax bills have been sent out. I always check out a selection of properties to see changes in the tax values here in Broadwater. I've used the "Just Market Value" to make these comparisons. Remember that the assessments are as of January 1, 2014, so will not reflect any improvements made during 2014.

Most of the increases in just market value that I've checked have an 11-12%

increase, but random checks in the neighborhood show increases from 6% to 18%. On the same block I've seen 13% and 18%. Two new homes within the same block are 6% and 11%.

#### HOLIDAY TRASH & RECYCLING SCHEDULE

Trash Collection for Christmas and New Year's Day weeks will be on Monday and Wednesday and Recycling will be picked up on Friday.

#### FLOOD INSURANCE submitted by Mary Lisan

Depending on where you live and when your home was built, you may be eligible for a less expensive rate on your current flood insurance. If there was a Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) in existence for your location when your home was built and you have an elevation certificate that states how far above sea level you are on your way to finding out if you are eligible.

- 1) Find and copy your Elevation Certificate. The information on it that you are interested in is the FIRM ID number and your elevation. If a FIRM was not in place, it will say so on the certificate (You would not be eligible).
- 2) Go to the StPete.org website and copy your property card. The information that you are interested in is when it was built. In your browser, type or copy and paste the following: <a href="http://stpete.org/">http://stpete.org/</a>
- Look on the left side of the page and find: Other City Services
- Go to Research/View (the 4<sup>th</sup> item down) and click on the down arrow and choose Property Cards
- You will be on a page labeled Questsys Web Client. Choose the tab at the top that says SEARCH
- In the Category line (3<sup>rd</sup> down from the top), click the down arrow and choose Property Card from the list
- In the first line of the items that come up next, put your street address (you don't need city, state or zip)
- In the bottom of that box, click Search
- Your results will show up under that, click on the hyperlink that appears with your address on it
- Your Property Card document will appear on the right side of the box you were using. Below the General Information about your property should be other files listed. These will be permits issued by the city on your property.
- I copied all of mine to a Word Document so I could enlarge them to see the writing. I found the dates of the initial permits and all subsequent ones.
- 3) Ask your St Petersburg Permitting Official what FIRM was used when permitting the building of your home. If it agrees with your Elevation Certificate, you would then ask the Permitting Official for a letter stating that your home was built "IN COMPLIANCE". It will cost approximately \$60.
- 4) Send all the information to your Insurance Company and ask them to adjust your rate from Pre-FIRM to IN COMPLIANCE.



#### **BLOCK CAPTAINS**

We welcome Brian Dault as the new Block Captain for 38<sup>th</sup> St. S on the north side of Broadwater. Many thanks to the 23 Block Captains who are your street level representatives in Broadwater. Each street or area has a Block Captain assigned to be your first contact for neighborhood questions or concerns as well as lost and found pets. Block Captains also hand deliver the Broadwater Breeze and can collect your 2015 membership dues. They provide a presence on your block and are a key to the success of

Broadwater. You can find a list of the Block Captains under the Contact Us tab at <a href="www.Broadwaterfl.org">www.Broadwaterfl.org</a>. #### RESIDENTIAL LIGHTING (GOOD NEIGHBOR GUIDE)

Did you know that there is an International Dark Sky Association (IDA)? Well, there is, and they have guidelines and suggestions about how to light your property for enhanced safety while not creating glare for your neighbors. Did you know that unshielded fixtures create glare and splatter light everywhere and may make a property less safe by not focusing the light where it is needed. You may not be aware of how your neighbors are affected by the light trespass coming off your property. Some of the points made by IDA are:

- Dark sky friendly lighting does not mean dark ground.
- Safety is important, but brighter does not mean safer.

A starry sky is a natural resource.

These are just a few of the highlights from the newsletter put out by IDA. If you have an issue with light pollution, talk to your neighbor and have them over to see things from your perspective and check out the full document at <a href="https://www.darksky.org">www.darksky.org</a> or <a href="https://www.darksky.org">www.broadwaterfl.org</a>

#### PET REGISTRY

The Broadwater Pet Registry is designed to help lost pets find their way home. If you have not registered your pet yet, there are several ways to do it. Please update us if your pet was previously registered and is no longer with you.

#### Broadwater Neighborhood Watch


